2. June 5th 2010 World Environment Day : Shillong College and Shillong College Academic Society in Collaboration with the State Council of Science, Technology and Environment observed the World Environment Day-2010 with sapling plantation at Smit (NSS adopted village) and organised painting competition for students in the college.
