THE COLLEGE EMBLEM

The White Background in the middle stands for our humble beginnings when a few noble, caring and dedicated souls established this college on 15th August 1956 in order to address and cater to the needs of the less privileged sections of society for whom higher education and the world of knowledge would have practically remained out of bounds. This color also stands for simplicity, purity, transparency and clarity of thought achieved through knowledge.

The Lamp in the white circle represents the illuminating, guiding and purging light of knowledge, wisdom and truth that will banish/dispel fear, doubt, ignorance, parochialism, bigotry and prejudice.

The significance of the Swan which is seen next to the lamp may be found in Hindu mythology where Saraswati, the Goddess of Knowledge is depicted riding a swan (hamsa) which symbolises purity par excellence (Sattva Guna), wisdom, prudence and the discerning power to differentiate between good and bad, eternal and transient (Viveka) discipline, stamina, grace and beauty.

The Ocean over which the swan appears, represents the unfathomable vastness of wisdom and depth of the world of knowledge as well as the collective human race where diverse elements co-exist.

The Golden Circle that surrounds all of the above symbolises the immortal nature of knowledge and the element of continuity in the work of disseminating knowledge. The colour itself reflects optimism, high ideals, enlightenment and the bright future for our students and college.

The Motto that appears in Sanskrit – “Vidyaya Vindate Amritam” – and in English – “Knowledge is Immortal”- is taken from Kena – Upanishad (11:4). In this context, knowledge as ‘Vidyaya’ implies a deeper meaning than mere learning. It is a state of mind where the individual is attuned to the divine consciousness and thus attains knowledge that is immortal and blissful.
