V. HIGHLIGHTS OF OTHER IMPORTANT ACTIVITIES DURING THE PERIOD

1. Dr. (Mrs.) M. P. R. Lyngdoh retired as Principal of the College on 1st January, 2011 and Dr. Malay Dey, Vice Principal, took over as the officiating Principal of Shillong College till appointment of a regular Principal of the College.
2. The Shillong College Unit Meghalaya College Teachers’ Association organized a Farewell Party for Dr. (Mrs.) M. P. R. Lyngdoh on 29th march, 2011. The retiring Principal also released the Annual Magazine 2011 of the college during the function.
3. One Year Certificate Course on “Computer Application” started from March, 2011.
4. Dr. Malay Dey, In-charge Principal of the College, attended the Award Ceremony organised by National Accreditation and Assessment Council, NAAC, Bangalore on 24th April, 2011, at Bangalore, and received the Grade Certificate awarded by NAAC, Bangalore, on re-accreditation and re-assessment of the College with CGPA 2.92.
5. A student-oriented interactive programme on “The importance of Mathematics and its various applications” was organized by the Department of Mathematics on 7th May, 2011. Dr. S. L. Marbaniang, eminent (retired) Professor of Mathematics, NEHU, was the Resource Person and infused the students to take studies of mathematics as their career option.

8. A number of Environment Awareness programmes were organised on the occasion of World Environment Day 2011 by the Shillong College Academic Society in collaboration with Shillong College which was sponsored by Indian Overseas Bank, Shillong, and State Council of Science, Technology & Environment, Meghalaya. The theme of the WED 2011, as declared by United

Nations, was “Forests: Nature at Your Service”. The different events organised included distribution of Leaflets on Environment Awareness to students and members of general public in rural and urban areas, wearing of Environment Badges by students, teachers and members of public, popular talk by Dr. B.
