### **III. HIGHLIGHTS OF OTHER IMPORTANT ACTIVITIES DURING THE PERIOD**

1. On 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2013, IQAC, of the College organised a Book release function in which a book entitled, “Thought and Reality – A critical study of Hegel’s Philosophy” authored by Dr. K. Dhirendro Ramsiej, Principal of the College, was released. The Book was released by Shri H. D. R. Lyngdoh, Hon’ble Minister for PWD etc., Government of Meghalaya, who appreciated the efforts of Dr. Ramsiej in coordinating academics with administrative work so efficiently. Prof. L. Moa, Department of Philosophy, North Eastern Hill University, gave the key note address in the programme underlining some aspect of Hegel’s philosophy and efforts of Dr. Ramsiej in taking insight of the philosophy.
2. National Seminar on “Convergence of Accounting Standards (for Reporting Purpose)” was organised on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2013, in the college conference hall by the Department of Commerce & Management of the College and the Shillong College Academic Society. The conference was inaugurated by Shri W. M. S. Pariat, IAS, Hon’ble Chief Secretary to the Government of Meghalaya at 10.00 a.m. on 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2013. A number of resource persons and delegates from different parts of the country including those from the state of Meghalaya attended the seminar and this included Prof. Bhabatosh Banerjee, Guest faculty of IIM, Kolkata, Prof. Sujit Sikidar from Gauhati University, Guwahati, Prof. G. Soral, Department of Accounting and Statistics, Mohallal Sukhadia University, Udaipur, Rajasthan, Prof. S. K. Basuy, St. Xavier’s College, Kolkata, Prof. K. C. Kabra, Department of Commerce, North Eastern Hill University, Shri S. Mukherjee and Shri R. K. Jha from North East Electric Power Corporation, NEEPCO. Shillong. The seminar ended with a valedictory function held on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2013, at 3.00 p.m. All together 183 participants including the resource persons, delegates, paper presenters and student delegates attended the seminar.
3. World Environment Day 2013 was celebrated by the Shillong College Academic Society in association with Shillong College and the NSS Unit of the College in the college campus. A day-long cleaning drive was taken up in the college campus. In view of the upcoming visit of the Union HRD Minister, no further detailed programme was taken up.
4. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College has taken a number of initiatives for upgrading the academic activities of the college. At the instance of the IQAC, a detailed programme was drawn up to celebrate the “Golden Jubilee of Teaching Science in Shillong College” with year-long activities with main the main events being organised from 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2013 to 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2013. However, the inauguration of the celebration was planned to be held on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2013.

5. The 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2013, marked as one of historical occasions in the annals of the College when Dr. M. M. Pallam Raju, the Honourable Union Minister of Human Resource Development visited the college and formally inaugurated the year-long celebration of “Golden Jubilee of Teaching Science in Shillong College”. The Inaugural Function was also graced by Dr. R. C. Laloo, Hon’ble Deputy Chief Minister and Minister in-charge of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Meghalaya. The Key note address was delivered by Prof. A. N. Rai, Vice-Chancellor of North Eastern Hill University. Dr. M. M. Pallam Raju also laid the foundation stone of the Sports Infrastructure Complex in the college campus which is to be built with financial assistance from UGC. The programme also included a grand cultural extravaganza in the afternoon session.
6. A two day long Orientation Programme for new joined NSS volunteers was conducted on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 at the College Conference Hall.
7. The NSS Unit of the College organised an awareness programme on Drug Addiction and Alcoholism in collaboration with the New Hope Centre Shillong. About 150 volunteers attend the programme where Mr. Perry Wahlang, Counsellor of New Hope Centre was the Resource person. The NSS Cell of the College also celebrated the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit trafficking on the theme “Safe Secure Shillong” on 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2013.
8. The NSS unit of the college conducted a Seven day Special Camping Programme at Nongmadan Village, East Khasi Hills District, from 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2013., the volunteers took part in construction of the village footpath (270 meters), socio-economic survey of the village, a free medical cum Eye Check-up camp and many others.
9. One Day Cleaning Drive programme of the College on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2013, on the occasion of World Environment Day.
10. The NSS Unit of the College organised a Blood Donation Camp on the 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2013, at the college campus in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club, Shillong College, the Regional Blood Bank, Pasteur Institute, Shillong and the Meghalaya AIDS Control Society. 21 units of blood were donated on that day.
11. The NSS Unit of the College also celebration the Sadbhavana Day on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2013 in the college campus to promote communal harmony and national integration
12. A Translation Workshop on Functional Hindi was organized by the Department of Hindi and Garo, jointly, on the 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2013, in the College Conference Hall.
13. Week-long main events of the Golden Jubilee of the “Teaching Science in Shillong College” was organised from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2013. The different programme organised are as follows:
  - (a) The main events of the Golden Jubilee of Teaching Science in Shillong College then started on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2013, with the launching of events which was flagged off by Shri Abu Taher Mondal, the Hon’ble Speaker of Meghalaya Legislative Assembly. The Chief Guest also released a Souvenir brought out on the occasion. To mark the flagging off of the events, the chief guest of the day released a bunch of balloons tied with a banner in it. This was followed by Students’ Science Seminar for Class IX-X on the topic: “Science, Technology and Meghalaya: 40 years now 40 years hence”.
  - (b) An International Seminar on “Attracting Best Talents in Basic Sciences” was held on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> July 2013 at Shillong College. The Seminar was inaugurated by Dr. Mukul Sangma, the Hon’ble Chief Minister of Meghalaya as the Chief Guest in the presence of Shri P. B. O. Warjri, the then Addl. Chief Secretary, Govt. of Meghalaya as the Guest of Honour. Prof K. G. Bhattacharya, from the Department of Chemistry, Gauhati University delivered the keynote address in which he stressed on the declining rate of students pursuing basic sciences not only in India but even in America. In this platform the Chief Minister of the State, Dr. Mukul Sangma also declared to the delight of all about the award of a special scholarship for the students who pursue their higher studies in basic sciences. We can say that Shillong College had done something good for our student community in particular and to the society in general. So in this regard, I cheer for Shillong College. The Seminar was attended by about 100 delegates from within and outside the country. The delegates are from our neighbouring country Bangladesh, and far-off country US, and also the National delegates from the neighbouring states of Assam. The technical sessions of the Seminar was followed by a Panel Discussion to emphasise on the theme of the seminar and also on the queries. The Seminar then came to a close at the formal

Valedictory programme where the Valedictory address was delivered by Dr. A. Goswami, Former HOD Chemistry, Cotton College, Guwahati, where she expressed herself and made her deliberations as an experienced teacher of Science. The National & International delegates expressed their happiness & appreciation for the kind hospitality shown by the College fraternity during their stay here.

- (c) A two day science exhibition was organised in the college on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> July 2013, which was inaugurated by Dr. Dilip Kumar Saikia, Director of National Institute of Technology, Shillong, on the 26<sup>th</sup> July 2013 at 10.00 am. Exhibition was organized in two categories – (a) Demonstrative – Participated by various Govt. Depts. and (b) Competitive – Participated by students of various Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools/Colleges. Altogether fifteen Schools participated in this exhibition. Exhibits were of high standard and the student participants showed great interest in showcasing their talents. The exhibition got a good response from visiting students & teachers from various Schools and Colleges in and around the city. More than three thousand students and teachers from different schools and colleges have visited the exhibition. In each group, merit prizes and consolation prizes have been declared. As a whole the exhibition has achieved its goal and was a successful one.
  - (d) Simultaneously, on the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2013, popular talks were organised which were delivered by (i) Dr. S. K. Malhotra (Head of Public Awareness Division, DAE, Mumbai) on the topic: “General Public Perception & Realities About Atomic Energy”. (ii) Dr. S. Sudhakar (Director of North Eastern Space Application Centre, Barapani, Meghalaya) on the topic: “Space Technology for the benefit of North Eastern Region”; (iii) Mr... Lyngdoh (SCSTE, Govt. of Meghalaya); and (v) Mr. R. Chatterjee, Asst. Teacher, Jail Road Boys Higher Secondary School, Shillong, and an alumnus of the College on the topic:”Your Cosmic Connection”.
  - (e) Inter College Debate and Quiz Competitions for Undergraduate students were organised on the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2013.
  - (f) 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2013, was marked as an Alumni Day for students and teachers that included some innovative programmes such as demonstrative teaching by the retired teachers of science stream and discussion that followed the teaching process. The afternoon session was a **panel discussion** on the future of Science Education in Colleges: Challenges & Opportunities. This was an open forum where the past students and teachers were involved to suggest plans and programmes for widening scope of education in Science streams in particular & in the College in general.
  - (g) At the end of our week-long events, we had a Valedictory function on the 30<sup>th</sup> of July 2013, which was graced by Shri Rowell Lyngdoh, the Deputy Chief Minister, Govt. of Meghalaya as the Chief Guest, who also distributed the prizes for various competitions. We had witnessed many of our invitees like our past teachers; Governing Body Members, Alumni members, dignitaries’ & the Govt. Officials from the different departments were also present on that day.
  - (h) As a part of the Golden Jubilee programme, the Mathematics Department organized a seminar on “Mathematics: The Need of the Hour” which was held on 5<sup>th</sup> July and 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2013, that was participated by teachers and students from various schools and colleges. The programme also marked the celebration of “National Year of Mathematics”.
  - (i) A Science Seminar Competition for the Physics Honours students of different colleges of the State, was organized by the Physics Department of the college on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of December 2013, in which Shillong College bagged the first prize and the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize was awarded St. Edmund’s College, Shillong.
14. A workshop on “Real Life on Reel” was organised by the Departments of Garo and Hindi on the 26<sup>th</sup> of August, 2013, in the college campus. Students from other colleges in addition to the students of Shillong College participated in the Workshop. Documentary and Feature Film were screened in which Shri Banjop Mukhim, Senior Correspondent Chief, Press Trust of India was the resource person.

15. Inter School Debate and Recitation Competitions in Hindi and Singing Competition for the Students of Shillong College was organised by the Departments of Garo and Hindi, Shillong College on the 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2013, as a part of Hindi Diwas Celebration 2013. The topic of the debate was "Internet is a boon in today's world".
16. The Entrepreneurship Development Cell of the College organised an UGC-sponsored Three Months Certificate Course in 'Entrepreneurship Development', which commenced on 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2013. Twenty eight (28) participants enrolled for the course and a number of expert resource persons in addition to those from the college conducted various sessions and dealt extensively on the course content. The training imparted was mainly based on a practical approach towards entrepreneurship development. As a part of the course Two-day Training on Confidence Building and Creative Thinking was arranged on 25<sup>th</sup> and 27 August, 2013. The programme also included (a) field trip to the Export Promotion Industrial Park (EPIP), Byrnihat; (b) Hand-on training on Food Processing; (c) two-day Residential Workshop at Rural Resource Training Centre (RRTC), Umran on 21 and 22 August, 2013. The evaluation process for the batch was held on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2013. The programme finally came to close with Course Closure-cum-Felicitation Programme held on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2013

20. Popular talk on "Human Trafficking" delivered by Ms. R. Lyngdoh, INGON, organised by Women Cell on 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2013.
21. Interactive Active Programme on Basic Sociological Fact was organised by Sociology Department. Prof. A. K. Nongkynrih, Department of Sociology, NEHU was the resource person. The programme was held on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2013.
22. Fare well for Degree final year students was organised by the S.C.S.U. on 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2013.
23. A study Tour cum excursion programme was conducted by the college. A team of 45 students led by four teachers, namely, Mrs. J. R. Gidon, Ms. Aibadalin Diengdoh, Shri T. WARjri and Shri S. Kharrymba, went for excursion on 27<sup>th</sup> December on 2012 and returned on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2013. The tour comprised visit to historical, cultural and scientific spots at Goa, Mumbai and Kolkata.
