12. Significant contributions made by IQAC during the current year (maximum five bullets)

- 1. Focus on organising International/National, Regional and State level Seminars, Conference, workshops, faculty development programmes, trainings etc. which are participated by renowned academicians from the country and abroad, policy makers, faculty, research scholars and others from all over the country which have greatly benefitted not only the college but the State and the country in general.
- Catalyst for Research, Innovation & Publication: Revising & improving the guidelines/criteria for college minor research project and enhancement of the total fund allocation from ₹ 2 lakhs to ₹ 4 lakhs per annum. The categories for the award of project are teacher's project and teacher-student project. The intention for these two categories is to promote research not just amongst the faculty but to imbibe the same in the students as well. With effect from April 2019 a maximum of ₹ 50,000 can be availed for one research project.
- The IOAC has spearheaded various publications and one of its significant contributions is the publication of the Interdisciplinary Journal "Echoes from the Hills" with ISSN: 2581-5253 (print) first released on the 24th July 2018. The 3rd Edition of the journal with the sub theme entitled "Sustainable Development - Possibilities and Challenges" will be released shortly.
- Continued focus on improving teaching-learning infrastructure and ICT equipment's and their maintenance for quality enhancement. Moreover, IQAC is striving for the introduction of PG Courses in other subjects. Notably, the college has applied for the introduction of M.A. in Khasi and application for this has been submitted to the affiliating university.
- 5. The IOAC has started the process of systematic Data Capture to enable the college to prepare for NAAC according to the RAAF and aim for complete computerization of all academic and administrative work including the admission process.
- 6. Develop student mentoring system, conduct Student Satisfaction Survey, systematic and concerted efforts for entrepreneurship, promoting environmental consciousness and Green Campus campaign, promoting student's participation in co-curricular and other activities that impart leadership training and universal values.
