

## ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT 2019-2020

For Alumni feedback an online google form is created and send to the college alumni, but the response is low, only 60 responded to the feedback, out of which 68.3 % are fresh alumni who passed out in the year 2020. The responses under each parameter is as follows:

- a. Relevance of the course curriculum in career plans – 45 % responded as very good, 26.7 % as excellent, 15 % as good, whereas the rest as average or poor.
- b. College environment – 38.3 % rated the environment as very good, 30 % as excellent, 28.3 % as good and the rest as average.
- c. Student-faculty relationship – 35 % rated the relationship as very good, 31.7 % as excellent, 28.3 % as good and only 5 % rated the relationship as average.
- d. Student-office staff relationship – 28.3 % rated the relationship as good, 21.7 % as very good, 20 % as average, 20 % as poor, as only 10 % as excellent.
- e. Training & placement facility – 31.7 % and 30 % rated very good and good respectively, 10 % as excellent, whereas 23.3 % and 5 % rated it as fair and poor.
- f. Library facilities – 35 % rated the library facility as excellent, 33.3 % as good, 28.3 % as very good, and the rest as average.
- g. Quality of reading and resource materials – Majority of the respondents i.e 28.3 %, 26.7 % and 38.3 % rated as excellent, very good and good, whereas only 6.7% rated the material as average.
- h. Infrastructural facilities: 28.3 % rated the college infrastructure as excellent, 35 % as very good, 30 % as good, and only 6.7 % as average.
- i. Sports and other development programs – 28.3 % responded as excellent, 38.3 % as very good, 20 % as good, whereas the rest responded as average and poor.
- j. Overall experience in college – 48.3 % rated their experience as excellent, 31.7 % as very good, 13.3 % as good, and only 6.7 % as average.
- k. Apart from the above parameters. 50 % are not pursuing higher studies, 85 % are not working yet and in search of a job. In addition, 75 % are not appearing in any competitive exams.
- l. 71.7 % responded that they are willing to participate in the college programs in future, 75 % are not yet members of the Shillong College Alumni Association, and finally, 81.7 % shows their willingness to become members of the association.
