

## Activities of The Department

1. The Department of Khasi has organized a field trip to Mawlangbna Village, East Khasi Hills District, for Khasi Honours students on the 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. The objective of the trip was to give the students an experience and explore the beauty of the Umkhakoi River.
2. The Department of Khasi organized a debate competition on the topic: **“Ki Dak Thoh – Ka Jinglong Kawei Ka Jaitbynriew”** in collaboration with Organizing Committee Diamond Jubilee, Shillong College. The programme was held in the Conference Hall, Shillong College on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017 and our college team bagged first runners up.
3. On the 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2017, the Department has organized a field trip to Shnongpdeng Village, West Jaiñtia Hills District, for the BA Khasi Honours students. The main objective of the trip was to enrich the students about the folk story of the Umngot and the Umiew River.
4. The Department of Khasi, Shillong College in Collaboration with the Khasi Authors’ Society organized a One day Seminar on **“Haba Im Ka Ktien, Im Ka Jaidbynriew”** on the 4<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2018 which held in Shillong College.
5. The Department organized a field trip to Mawphanlur Village, West Khasi Hills District, for the Khasi Honours students on the 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2018. The trip was a learning experience for the students on how to preserve the natural beauty and the surroundings of the environment.
6. The Department of Khasi organized a programme on **“B.C Jyrwa Memorial Lecture”** on the 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. This programme is to commemorate one of the teaching staff from the department who was the famous writer and had contributed to the Literature of Khasi.
7. On the 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2019, The Department organized a field trip to Markham Village, West Khasi Hills District, for the Khasi Honours students. The main objective of the trip was to give the students an insightful knowledge about the richness of the Khasi culture, an indigenous tribe of Meghalaya. This was also the day that the Meghalaya Tourism Department organized Ri Khaiñ Autumn Festival in Markham Village which located near Tiehnongbah Lummurok Viewpoint, West Khasi Hills District.

The Department of Khasi in Collaboration with IQAC, Shillong College has organized two days Webinar on “**Ka Jaitbynriew Hynñiew Trep ha ka Jingäid lynti ba 50 snem**” on the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2021. The department organised this programme to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> years of Statehood. The function was graced by the M. L. A of Mawryngkneng Constituency, Shri Pynäid Sing Syiem as the Chief Guest, Prof. L. S. Gassah was the keynote speaker in this programme, Prof. B. Myrboh (President GB of Shillong College) address the gathering and Dr.(Smt.) E. Kharkongngor, Principal of the Shillong College deliver a speech on this function. The Two-Day Webinar had four technical sessions arranged to provide a forum for all the Resource Persons.

9. A field trip to Janailar Falls, Mawkma, East Khasi Hills District, organized by the Department of Khasi for the Khasi Honours students on the 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2021.
