
REPORT ON

An awareness talk on Anti Ragging organized by the SHILLONG College Students' Union in collaboration with the Anti-Ragging Cell was held on 3rd August 2022 at the College auditorium for the First semester students.

The resource persons for this programme were Mr B. Mawlong, MCS and Mr I. R. Ranee Advocate and guest faculty, Law Department NEHU.



While addressing the students at the programme Mr B. Mawlong referred to his younger days in his engineering college in Hyderabad. Stating, that ragging is a western concept he referred to how in India it was earlier taken as a social interaction between seniors and juniors. However, today ragging has become a serious issue as it has destroyed not just careers but also lives. Enlightening on what constitutes ragging Mr. Mawlong also pointed to the effects of ragging. While expressing happiness that the students' council and the management of the college is not passive to this issue he also urged the students not to indulge in ragging and to use the mechanisms in place to report any such cases if they happen.



B. MAWLONG TALK PRINCIPALS' ADDRESS


The second resource person Shri I.R. Ranee at the very beginning of his talk interacted with the students and asked them as to what the term Ragging meant to them. Highlighting on the Aman movement he narrated as to how the UGC Anti Ragging Act 2009 originated. Referring to Meghalaya and the non-presence of the state law pertaining to ragging he stated that the central regulations which include the Indian Penal Code, UGC Anti Ragging Act 2009 thereby come into play rendering Ragging as a very serious issue. He also informed the students about the mechanism of Ragging in place in the college to address such cases.
