
Brief Report on Workshop on Mathematics through Origami & National Mathematics Day (NMD),2021

A 2 Day Workshop on Mathematics thro' Origami was organised jointly by the State Council of Science, Technology and Environment, Meghalaya and Mathematics Department, Shillong College, Shillong supported by NCSTC, DST, Government of India on the 16th & 17th November, 2021 at Shillong College conference hall. The Main resource person in this particular workshop is Shri V.S.S.Sastry, Mathematics Communicator from Vigyan Prasar, New Delhi where the Maths ambasssadors of the SCSTE and the Mathematics honours students of Shillong College were the participants of the workshop. Shri V.S.S.Sastry inaugurated the 2 Day workshop in presence of Dr. (Mrs.) E. Kharkongor, principal of Shillong College and the officials of the council together with the faculty of mathematics department, Shillong College. In this workshop, maximum time has been dedicated to new way of learning basic school mathematical concepts through Origami (the art of paper folding) and many origami models has been developed by the participants during the 2 day workshop. Shri James K. Sangma, Minister of Health& Family Welfare, Government of Meghalaya graced the valedictory function as the Chief Guest. The Principal of Shillong College delivered the welcome address in the valedictory function of the 2 Day workshop. The chief guest in his valedictory address said that only 12% of the students in the state of Meghalaya opted for science stream in the higher secondary level after the SSLC Examination because most of the students has no clear basic concepts in mathematics and this has led to the mathematics phobia in many of them. The Chief Guest hoped that this kind of workshop not only it brings new way of understanding mathematics but it will change the way the students look at mathematics especially at the school level through this art of paper folding (Origami). Shri A.S. Suting, OSD, SCSTE motivated the participants with his motivational speech and the 2 Day workshop ended up with a feedback note from participants and the Chief Guest distributed the certificates to all the participants.
