

CAREER AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON “BEAUTY AND WELLNESS”

NSS Unit, Shillong College, conducted a One Day Awareness Programme on “Career Opportunities in Beauty and Wellness Sector” for Volunteers on the 19th July, 2022 in the College Conference Room from 10 a.m. onwards. In this programme Smti.
