5th July 2017 – INVESTITURE CEREMONY

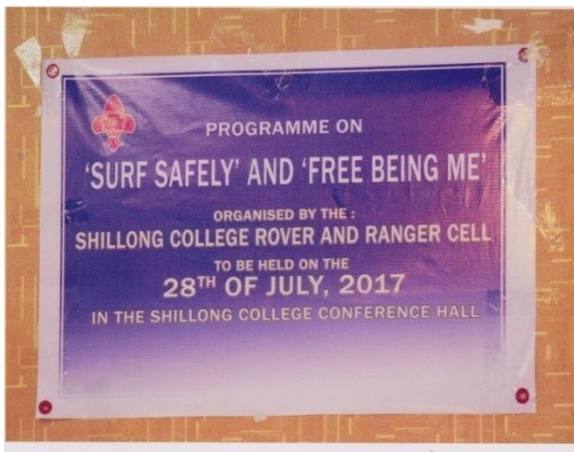
