



FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2017-2018

Based on the analysis of the feedback collected from the teaching, students, and alumni, the college has taken certain steps to ensure development and make improvements to serve better such as:

- i. To strengthen the infrastructural facilities, the C Block of the college as well as the indoor stadium is undergoing construction.
- ii. The college plans to introduce post graduate courses affiliated to North Eastern Hills University and to design Add-on courses to cater to the needs of the students.
- iii. Classrooms are installed with LCD projectors in a phase wise manner, and teachers are encourage to use ICT tools for their classes.
- iv. The college propose to redesign and renovate the office for easy accessibility for the students and to decrease the waiting line and time for different services.
- v. From time to time, the college encourages all department to look for fundings and organise seminars and conferences to empower all teachers and students with up-to-date knowledge in the different fields of study.
- vi. Places where installation of drinking water for students and staff are identified.
- vii. To improve the wi-fi facility in the institute the ICT Cell are to study the matter and report to the management.
- viii. For better Teaching – Learning Process, many teachers are encouraged to use ICT tools.
- ix. Since the internet facility for teachers and students are an ongoing problems the ICT Cell is looking into different avenues on how to improve Wi fi services.
- x. Heads of Departments are asked to look into the books in the library, and to place an order for more books with the librarians to increase the number of latest edition books and Reference books for the students.
- xi. The Canteen Committee takes the responsibility of ensuring better canteen facility.
- xii. Since many students complains about the toilets, the management propose to construct new toilets for both girls and boys.
- xiii. The management undertakes some green initiatives such as solar energy and Water harvesting to tackle the problems of shortage of power and water.
- xiv. The inspection and feasibility study for the development of the extended campus at Mawkasiang is undertaken.
- xv. The IQAC to collect feedback from other stake holders as well, such as Teaching Staff, Non-Teaching Staff, Alumni, and Parents, to get more views and opinions for the development and improvement to be able to serve the students better.
