Aims & Objectives:

With the increasing competition across the globe, people are always keen to attain success. This competition has also led to performance pressure on students increasing drastically. Out of the several guides present, one of them is the coaching institute/classes, which in most cases, plays a pivotal role in this dream of serious aspirants. Some students can rigorously prepare for their goals without external help; however, some need more support and discipline. Coaching classes help students with competent faculty and innovative teaching methods since the right guidance from the right tutor at the right time can help students achieve their goals smoothly. Coaching class for competitive exam is being organised mainly to impart the conceptual knowledge about the subject and syllabi of the various competitive exams conducted by SSC/IBPS/State Govt. Public sector etc. The financial constraint on the part of the students weight down their preparation for the said exam, as such free coaching class under government sponsored Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan Scheme (RUSA) is believed to bring changes and inculcate a competitive mind among the students.

The number of students who appear for competitive entrance exams is increasing every year, hence making it a stressful period for students. Some students are able to sail through this period without external help, however, some need more support. Coaching classes help students with competent faculty and innovative teaching methods.

Further, it will create awareness among the students relating to various competitive exams and it will guide them to prepared for various exams and enable them to be employed in various sectors. It is understood that through coaching class, problems related with unemployment can be reduced and makes the students a productive assets.

The coaching class will be conducted for a period of three months with a minimum of 3 hours per day into 6 day a week. The paper to be taught includes English, Maths, General

Intelligence & Awareness, General studies. Moreover, group discussion, Mock interview and personality development will be imparted to the students.

Brief Report of the Programme:

The coaching class for competitive exam is conducted by the College with financial support from RUSA. The conduct of the programme and its functioning comes under the supervision of ICGC of the college.

The ICGC nominated Shri P.Kipgen as the Coordinator and Shri L.Khongiang as Asst Coordinator to take accountability for the smooth conduct and completion of the course.

The coaching class for competitive exams 2022 under RUSA started from the 21st March, 2022 with students from different streams i.e. Arts, Science, Commerce, and professional departments of the college. The students admitted for the course are mainly from the 6th Semester. An application of 100 students has been shortlisted for the course. In order to have more focus and disseminate deeper information on subject concern, it has been limited to 100 students on first come first serve basis for a period of 4 months w.e.f 21/3/2022 to 21/7/22 tentatively with 15 classes per week.

The Inaugural Session was held on 21/3/22 in the presences of students and Resources person with other dignitaries. The programme was brief with speech from the dignitaries and the Vice Principal Prof. K D Roy and the Coaching Class was declared open by Madam Principal Dr.E.Kharkongor with a motivational and driving speech.







The coaching class mainly focus on Staff Selection Commission (SSC) and Banking Recruitment (SBI & IBPS) apart from other competitive Examination. Subjects taught include General Awareness (GA), General Intelligence & Reasoning (GI & R), Maths including Advance Maths and English.

Progress of classes:

Finance:

In order to meet various expenditure related with the course, a total of Rs 4,00,000 (Four Lakhs) has been received from RUSA for the conduct of the course. The money received has been fully utilised in meeting payment (honorarium) to the faculties, Study materials, printing & stationary, photo copying, miscellaneous etc.

Record Books Maintain:

In order to have proper record and more transparency, disclosure and control, various register/ books of accounts has been maintained which includes Student attendance Register, Registration, Honorarium Register, Income & Expenditure Account, other related cash memo and payment notes which are duly submitted to the concern authority.

Study Materials:

Students were provided study materials and other notes as and when required. Soft copy in PDF form has been disseminated through social media and hard copy also has been hand out.

Interview/ Mock test/ Group Discussions:

In order to prepare them for various interview and job recruitment, mock test is being conducted on different subject to test the progress of the skill and ability of the students. Further, under the guidance of Prof. P.Khonglah, Group Discussion on various hot topics related to economy, politics, history etc has been conducted. Mock interview with panellist from different institutions who are experts in various field are conducted to shape and developed their personality.

Impact of the programme on students academic performances:

As per feedback received from the students, the coaching class enabled them in preparing for various exams which they acquired during the four months course after being graduated and eligible for various exams.

Further, coaching class also makes them more knowledgeable on their degree subjects that help them to understand more on the subjects and act as motivating forces.

It guides and creates the habits of studying and making them prepared for their competitive exams as well as of their degree.

However, since some of the aspirant coaching student passed out in the current year i.e 2022, and many of them not being eligible for various exams, outputs from the course relating to employment are still awaited.
