Sl.No	Suggestion	Action taken
1.	Handwritten notes given by teachers should be replaced with printed one because sometimes the handwriting is not clear. Writing part for practical should be given with xerox sheet, not with old practical copy as it leads to confusion.	As per suggestion, teachers have handed down printed materials to the students.  Printed and standardized practical protocols were given to the students.
2.	Help students to understand the basic of learning through live exploring.	Students were taken for field study to get first-hand experience about what they have learnt in classroom. Students were taken to rivers and streams for water analysis experiments, taken to places for fossil observation and collection.
3.	Teacher-relationship should be made better to enhance the learning experience of the students.	For better interaction between teachers and students each student is assigned his/her mentor by the department. Moreover, in the class room teachers engage in discussion about academic matters as well as matters related to preparation for various entrance examinations and job opportunities creating a caring and closer student- teacher relationship.
4.	Discussion on the performance of assignments.	Assignments submitted by students were discussed with them individually and through comments made on their assignments. Also whenever necessary assignments were asked to be resubmitted after explanations to get a better understanding if they have grasped the topic or not.
