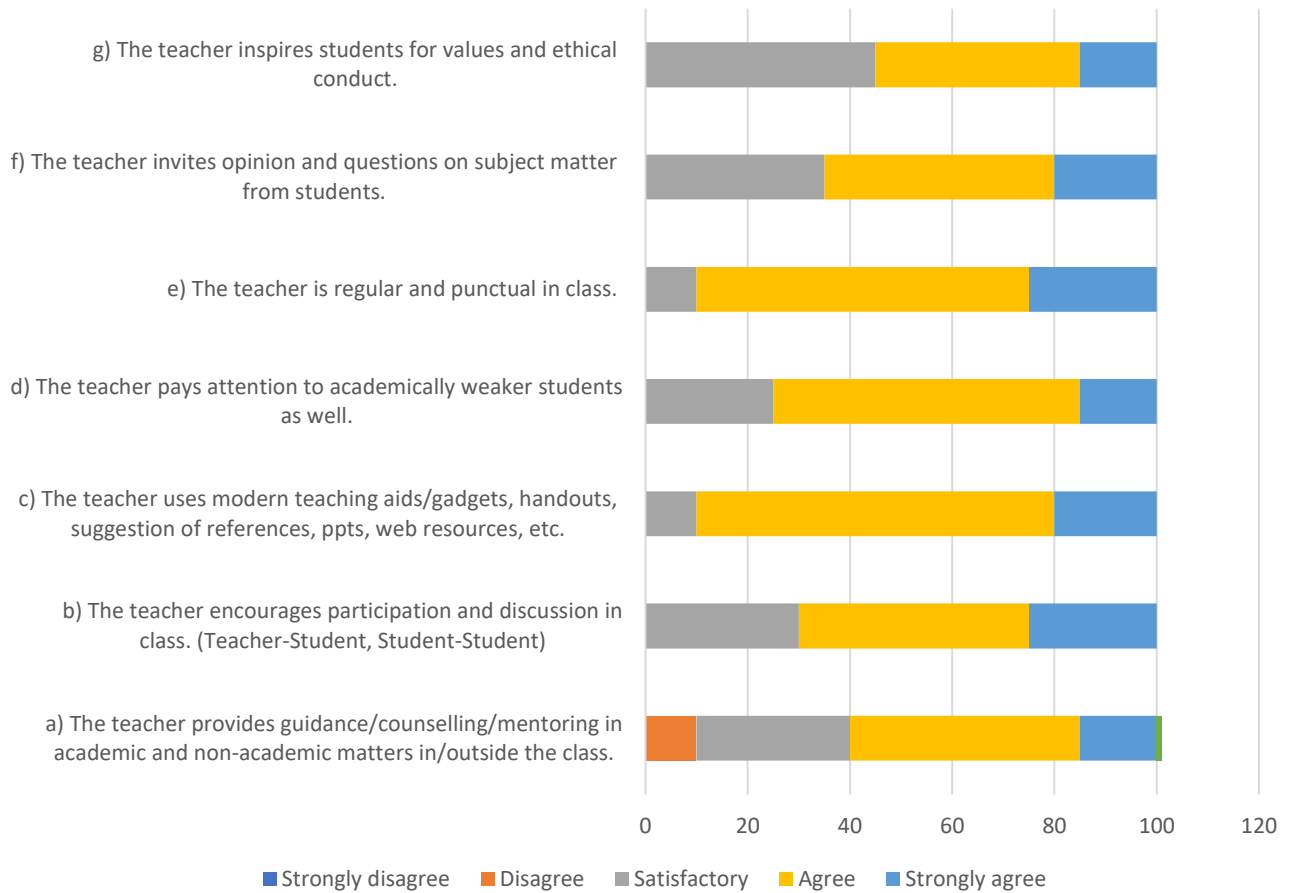


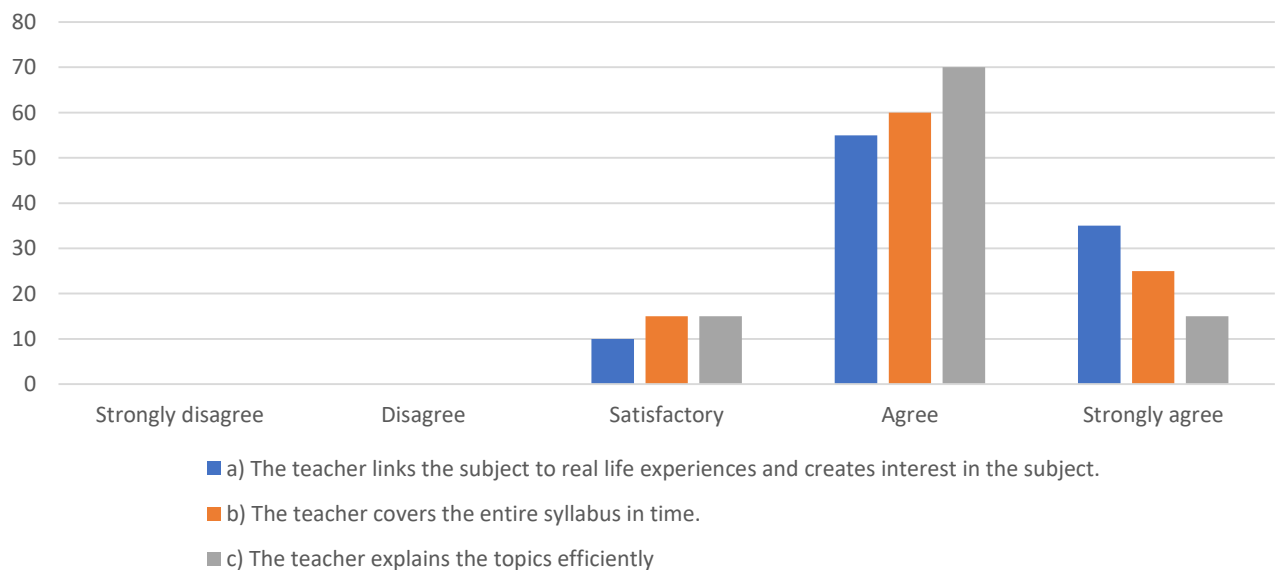

TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS (IN PERCENTAGE)

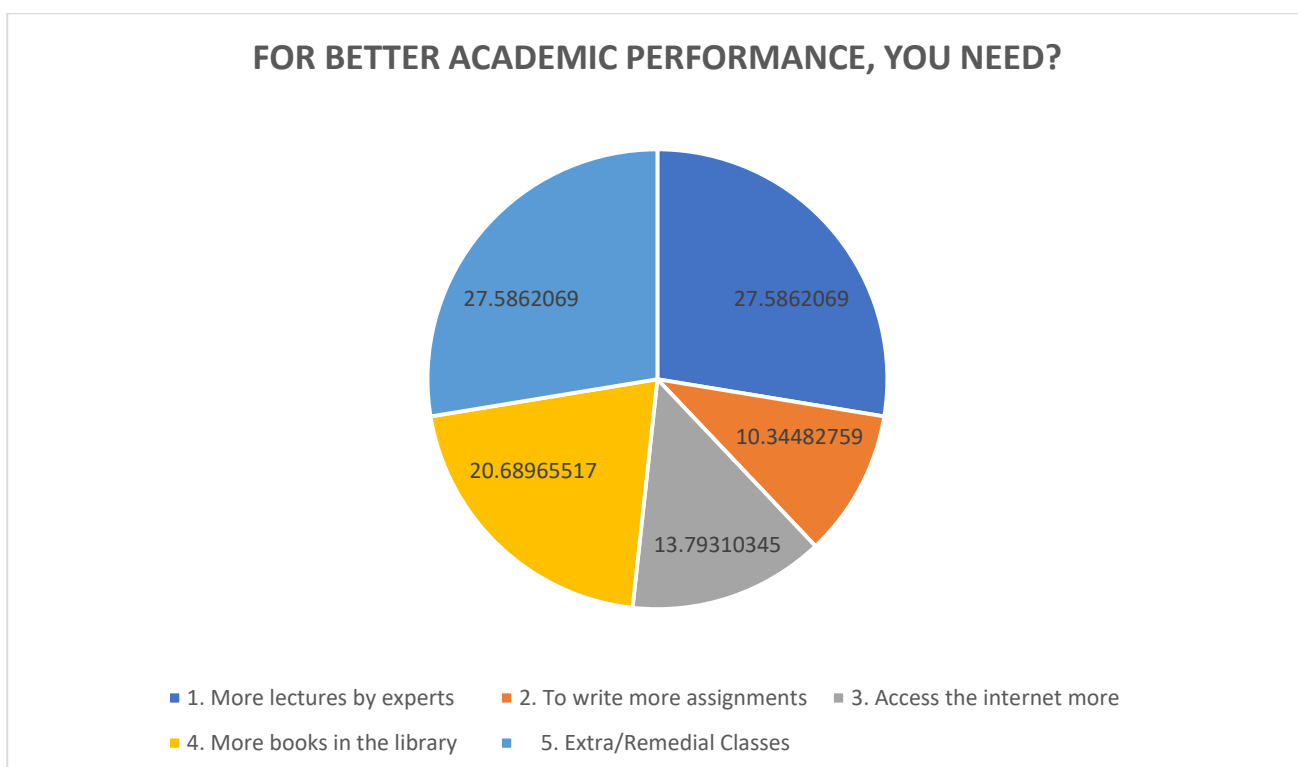
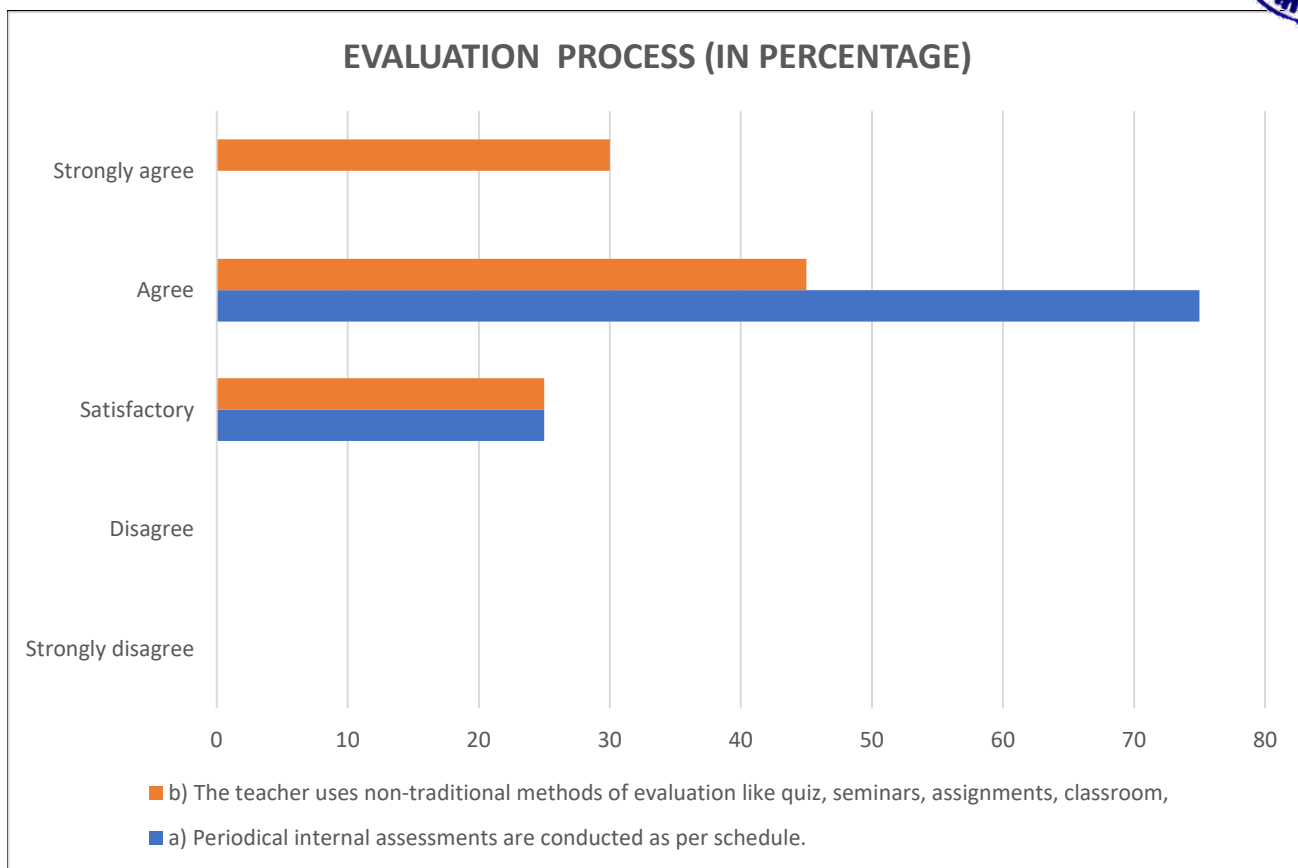


COURSE CONTENT (IN PERCENTAGE)





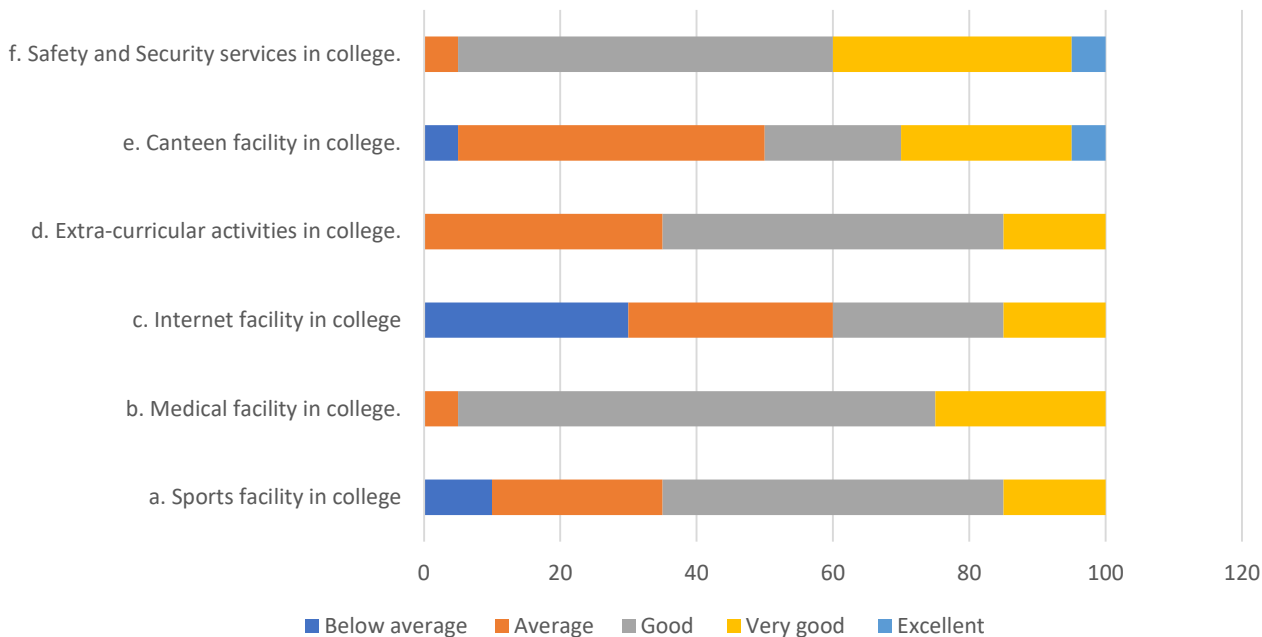

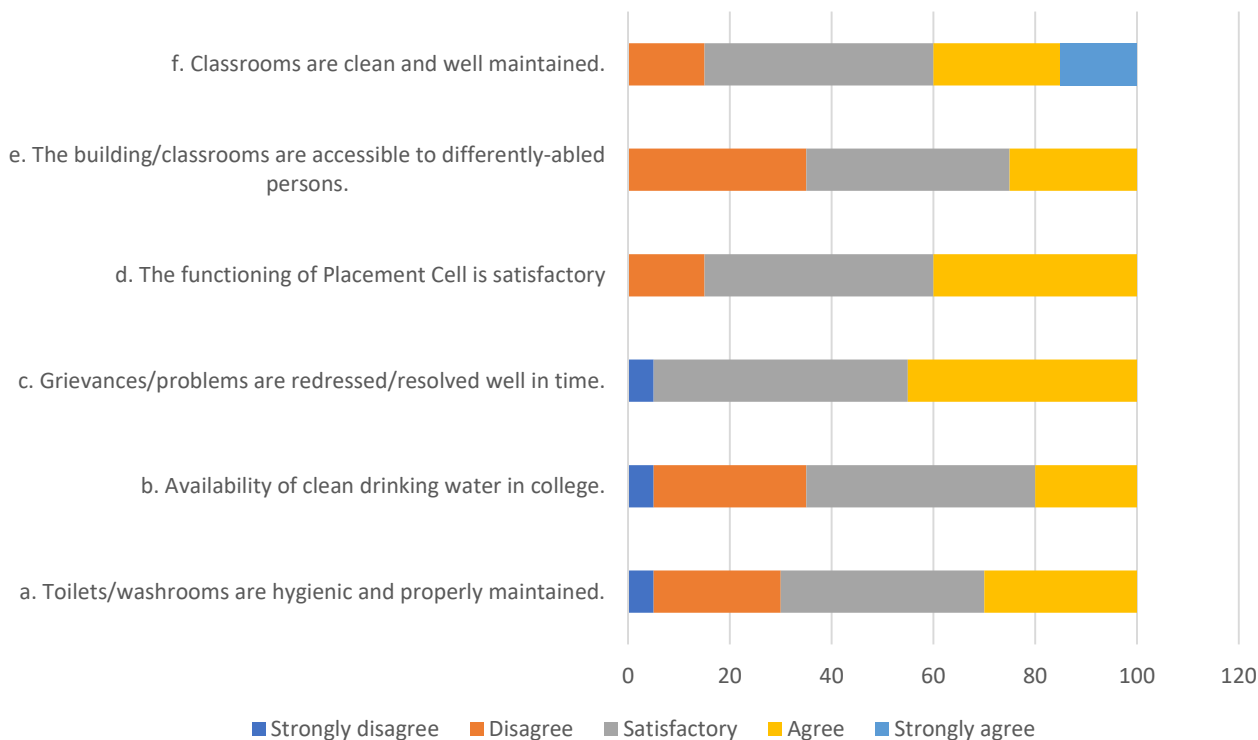

STUDENTS FEEDBACK FORM FOR COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE (IN PERCENTAGE)



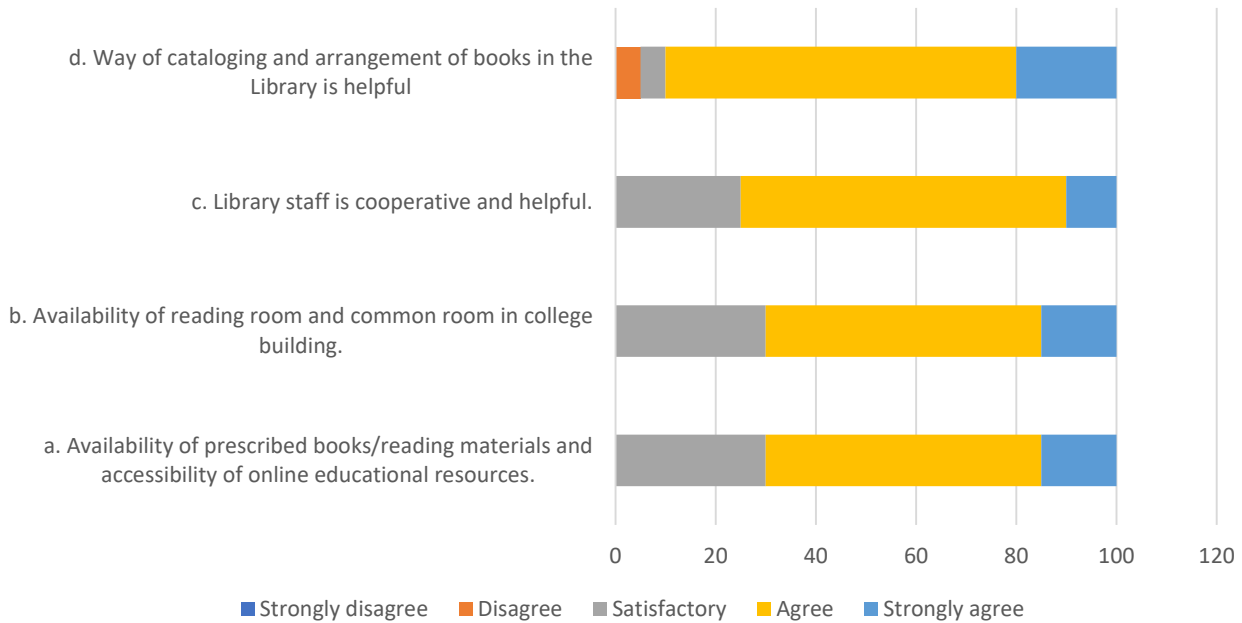
OTHER BASIC FACILITIES (IN PERCENTAGE)



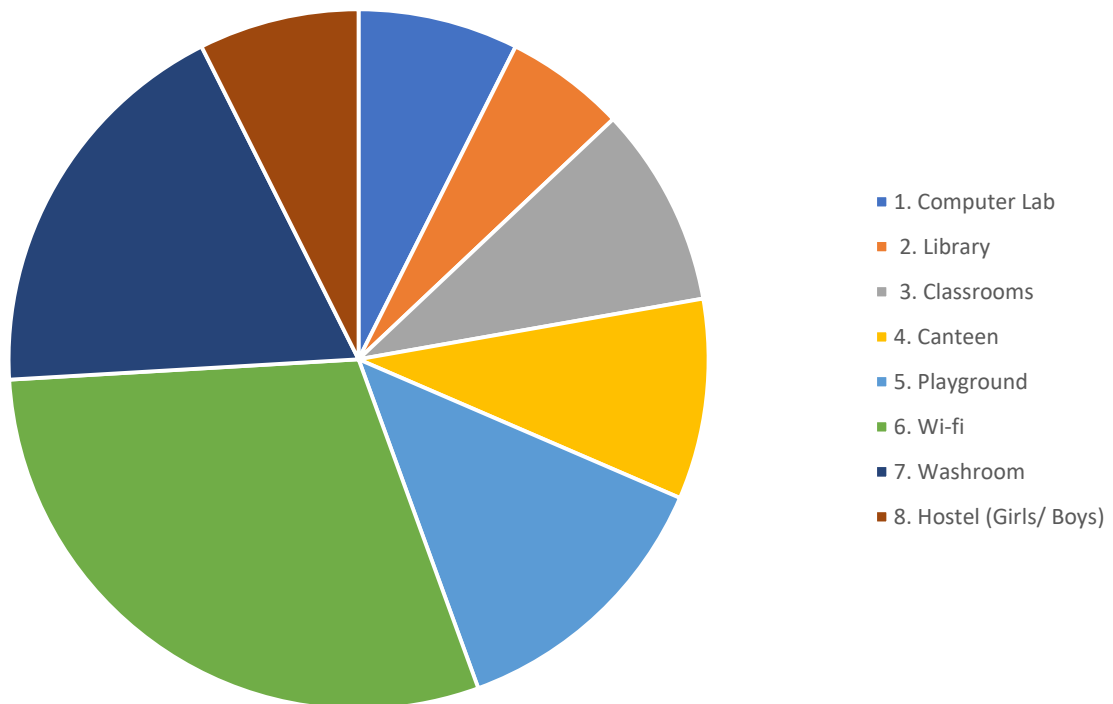

STUDENTS FEEDBACK 2021-2022 ANALYSIS REPORT:

The feedback was collected from a random sample of 30 % of the total number of students, which included all the semesters and streams as well. Based on their responses on the different parameters the report is as follows:

I. TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS:

- a) **The teacher provides guidance/counselling/mentoring in academic and non-academic matters in/outside the class:** 45 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 30 % responded as satisfactory, 15 % strongly agree, whereas 10 % disagree with the statement.
- b) **The teacher encourages participation and discussion in class. (Teacher-Student, Student-Student):** 45 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 30 % responded as satisfactory, and 25 % strongly agree.
- c) **The teacher uses modern teaching aids/gadgets, handouts, suggestion of references, ppts, web resources, etc.:** 70 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 20 % strongly agree and 10 % responded as satisfactory.
- d) **The teacher pays attention to academically weaker students as well:** 60 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 25 % responded as satisfactory and 15 % strongly agree.
- e) **The teacher is regular and punctual in class:** 65 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 25 % strongly agree and 10 % responded as satisfactory.
- f) **The teacher invites opinion and questions on subject matter from students:** 45 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 35 % responded as satisfactory, and 20 % strongly agree.
- g) **The teacher inspires students for values and ethical conduct:** 45 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 40 % responded as satisfactory, and 15 % strongly agree.

II. COURSE CONTENT:

- a) **The teacher links the subject to real life experiences and creates interest in the subject:** 55 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 35 % responded as strongly agree, and 10 % and satisfactory
- b) **The teacher covers the entire syllabus in time:** 60 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 25 % responded as strongly agree, and 15 % and satisfactory
- c) **The teacher explains the topics efficiently:** 70 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 15 % responded as strongly agree, and 15 % and satisfactory

III. EVALUATION PROCESS:

- a) **Periodical internal assessments are conducted as per schedule:** 75 % of the respondents agree to the statement, and 25 % responded as satisfactory
- b) **The teacher uses non-traditional methods of evaluation like quiz, seminars, assignments, classroom, presentations/participation (or any other method):** 45 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 30 % responded as strongly agree, and 25 % as satisfactory.
- c) **For better academic performance, do you think you need? - The responses are as follows:-**
 1. More lectures by experts - 28 %
 2. To write more assignments – 10 %
 3. More access the internet – 14 %
 4. More books in the library – 21 %
 5. Extra/Remedial Classes – 28 %

IV. CURRICULUM DESIGN:

- a) **The curriculum design/syllabus is well designed and up-to date which empowers students for better career prospects:** 60 % of the respondents agree to the statement, 35 % responded as satisfactory, and 5 % strongly agree.



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V. STUDENTS FEEDBACK FOR COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE:

- a. **Sports facility in college:** 50 % of the respondents says good, 25 % responded as average, 15 % as very good and 10% as below average.
- b. **Medical facility in college:** 70 % of the respondents says good, 25 % responded as very good, and 5 % as average
- c. **Internet facility in college:** 30 % of the respondents says below average, 30 % responded as average, 25 % as good and 15 % as very good.
- d. **Extra-curricular activities in college:** 50 % of the respondents says good, 35 % responded as average, 15 % as very good
- e. **Canteen facility in college:** 45 % of the respondents says average, 25 % responded as very good, 20 % as very good and 5 % as excellent.
- f. **Safety and Security services in college:** 55% of the respondents says good, 35 % responded as very good, 5 % as excellent and another 5 % responded as average.

VI. FEEDBACK ON OTHER BASIC FACILITIES:

- a. **Toilets/washrooms are hygienic and properly maintained:** 40 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 30% agrees, 25% disagree and 5 % strongly disagree.
- b. **Availability of clean drinking water in college:** 45 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 30% disagrees, 20% agrees and 5 % strongly disagree.
- c. **Grievances/problems are redressed/resolved well in time:** 50 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 45 % agrees, and 5 % strongly disagree.
- d. **The functioning of Placement Cell is satisfactory:** 45 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 40% agrees, and 15% disagree.
- e. **The building/classrooms are accessible to differently-abled persons:** 40 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 35% disagrees, and 25% agree.
- f. **Classrooms are clean and well maintained:** 45 % of the respondents responded as satisfactory, 25 % agrees, 15 % disagree and 15 % responded as excellent.

VII. LIBRARY:

- a. **Availability of prescribed books/reading materials and accessibility of online educational resources:** 55 % of the respondents responded as agree, 30% as satisfactory, and the rest 15 % as strongly agree.
- b. **Availability of reading room and common room in college building:** 55 % of the respondents responded as agree, 30% as satisfactory, and the rest 15 % as strongly agree.
- c. **Library staff is cooperative and helpful:** 65 % of the respondents responded as agree, 25% as satisfactory, and the rest 10 % as strongly agree.
- d. **Way of cataloging and arrangement of books in the Library is helpful:** 70 % of the respondents responded as agree, 20% as strongly agree, and the rest 5 % as satisfactory.

VIII. What areas of infrastructure, do you think need to be improved? : The responses are as follows :-

1. Computer Lab – 7.5 %
2. Library – 5.5 %
3. Classrooms – 10 %
4. Canteen – 9 %
5. Playground – 13 %
6. Wi-fi – 30 %
7. Washroom – 19 %
8. Hostel (Girls/ Boys) -7 % (approx.)

In conclusion, overall in many parameters the college is rated as satisfactory or good or very good, but base on the feedback certain areas still needs the attention of the management such as extra-curricular activities for students, sports facilities for more students, availability of drinking water, 24 hours water in the toilets as there is shortage of water in the toilets, internet facilities for students, ICT enabled classrooms and size of classroom



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due to certain problems faced by students, accessibility of classrooms for differently abled students and emergency exits. Certain suggestions were also made by the students such as:

- For canteen to maintain a menu with items and prices for visibility and information.
- For the students access to wi-fi facility in the college campus.
- For arrangement of more remedial classes and lectures for the students.
- For library to have more books for each subject for more students to issue.
- For better treatment of sewage water as the smell is coming to certain classrooms in Block D.
- For arrangement of more field study and exposures.
