
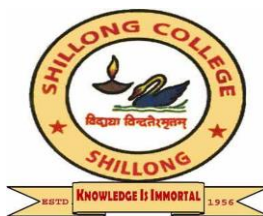


Minutes of the Meeting for BPES Held on 31st March, 2021.

1. The meeting was presided by the Principal Dr. E. Kharkongor. She called the meeting to order and welcomed the members.
2. The meeting was attended by 10 members
3. Brief discussion took place regarding seeking of permission to open BPE (Bachelor of Physical Education) and subsequently change of nomenclature to BPES (Bachelor of Physical Education and Sports). The opening permission was given in 2017 but due to non-formation of BOS (Board of Studies) the course could not be opened. However, as of now, NEHU has constituted the BOS and had communicated that the Syllabus needs to be revised and the affiliation for the Course may be sought.
4. It was decided that Shri C. Syiem in consultation with experts from NEHU will prepare and revised the syllabus to be submitted.
5. The following are the requirements for seeking permission for affiliation of the Course.
 - (a). 4 Class rooms of 50 capacity each. If possible, in Mawkasiang.
 - (b). Hostel facility for outside students.
 - (c). Gymnasium of 30 m x 40 m with all equipments.
 - (d). Laboratory.
 - (e). Library in Mawkasiang.
 - (f). Health Centre.
 - (g). Six faculty members out of which at least 3 members at the time of starting the Course.
6. Fees may be @ 16,000/- (excluding hostel) per Semester.
7. For the above Infrastructure sources of funds are to be explored.
8. Survey of the Mawkasiang Campus have to be carried out.
9. As no other matter was raised the meeting ended with thanks to the chair & vice – versa.

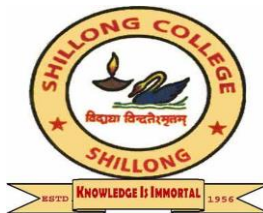


CONCEPT NOTE ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Shillong College was inaugurated on 15th of August 1956 and began with few students at Jail Road Boys High School. Shri Sudhindra Chandra Datta, a Lecturer in the Department of Mathematics in St. Anthony's College, became the founder Principal. Before the establishment of North Eastern Hill University in 1972, Shillong College was affiliated to Gauhati University. The birth, growth and development of Shillong College is a cumulative result of the immense sacrifice, dedication, hard work and perseverance of a good number of well-meaning selfless individuals as well as some prominent organizations of Shillong and the region as a whole.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COLLEGE:

- To provide quality education to all aspiring students through meaningful academic and professional courses keeping in mind the special needs of the economically, educationally, and socially disadvantaged segment of the society.
- To inculcate knowledge and need-based work skills so that the products of the college find themselves prepared for employment and self-employment avenues as and when required.
- To help students discover and explore their fullest potential through appropriate co- and extra-curricular activities, and sports leading to integrated personality development to become responsible and productive citizens of the country.
- To encourage and promote moral, secular, scientific and nation-building values so that the students respect, protect and nurture the rich composite culture of the country and of each of its constituent units.
- To create awareness, concern, and care for environment by gearing various collegiate activities to sustainable environmental practices encompassing the State's land, water, flora and fauna.

**AFFILIATION**

- The College is affiliated to North Eastern Hill University, Shillong (Under Graduate Courses).
- The College is also affiliated to Meghalaya Board of School Education, Tura (HSSLC Courses).
- The College is under Deficit Grants-in-Aid system of Government of Meghalaya and conforms to State government Rules & Regulations.
- The College is governed by a Governing Body, duly constituted as per UGC Guidelines and State Government Rules.
- The overall management of different courses offered by the College is looked after by Shillong College Educational Society (Registration No.: E.16(Rs)5/of 2006/71).

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Keeping in mind the goals and objectives of the college, the Department of Physical Education was established in the year 2014 with Higher Secondary Section for XI and XII Standard. Before that the college had proposed the subject of Physical Education along with the syllabus to the Meghalaya Board of School Education (MBOSE) Tura in the year 2013, taking initiative that the subject be included as one of the papers in the Higher Secondary level. The Board accepted the proposal of the college and approved the subject of Physical Education as one of the optional papers at Higher Secondary level. Thus, Shillong College is the first College in the state of Meghalaya to have proposed and introduced Physical Education subject as one of the papers at Higher Secondary level for Arts stream. Soon after



the approval from the Board, the College was granted permission to offer the paper as an optional subject to the students from the year 2014 onwards.

BPES (Bachelor of Physical Education and Sports)

Along with the opening of the Physical Education subject in the higher secondary section, the College had also taken initiative to approach the North Eastern Hill University for opening of the BPES course at the Undergraduate Level. In 2014 Opening Permission was given to the college to start Bachelor of Physical Education. However, the University advised the college to apply for Provisional Affiliation before admission of students can be done. In 2015 the North Eastern Hill University vide letter no. CDC/A.6/2014/Vol. III3649 dated: 24 June 2015 granted Provisional Affiliation for Bachelor of Physical Education (BPE). In 2016 the UGC vide letter D.O. No. F.5-1/2015(CPP-II) dated 31 May 2016 asked all universities to align the degrees with the ones specified by the UGC, in which new degrees were specified in the field of sports and BPE (Bachelor of Physical Education) was changed to BPES (Bachelor of Physical Education and Sports). Hence, the college had to re-apply to the University for Provisional Affiliation in the course of BPES. The College had acquired 8.888 acres of land in New Shillong, Mawkasiang with the view of construction of the infrastructure for the BPES course. The basic levelling of the playground is already done and the swimming pool was completed and inaugurated in February 2021.



The Objectives of the Department of Physical Education and Sports are as follows:

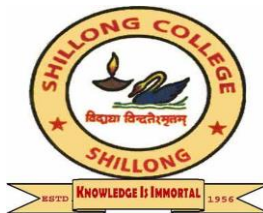
- To promote Physical Education and Sports programs at grass roots level.

FUTURE PROSPECT

The College has the earnest intention to expand the course to BPED and in due course of time to upgrade the Department to MPED. Additional certificate courses on Yoga, Aerobics, Lifeguard, Self-defence, First-Aid, Zumba, Physiotherapy are also being looked at as future add-on courses, which will be of additional help to the students for their placements. Placement is an important area that needs to be looked at as soon as the BPES course starts.
